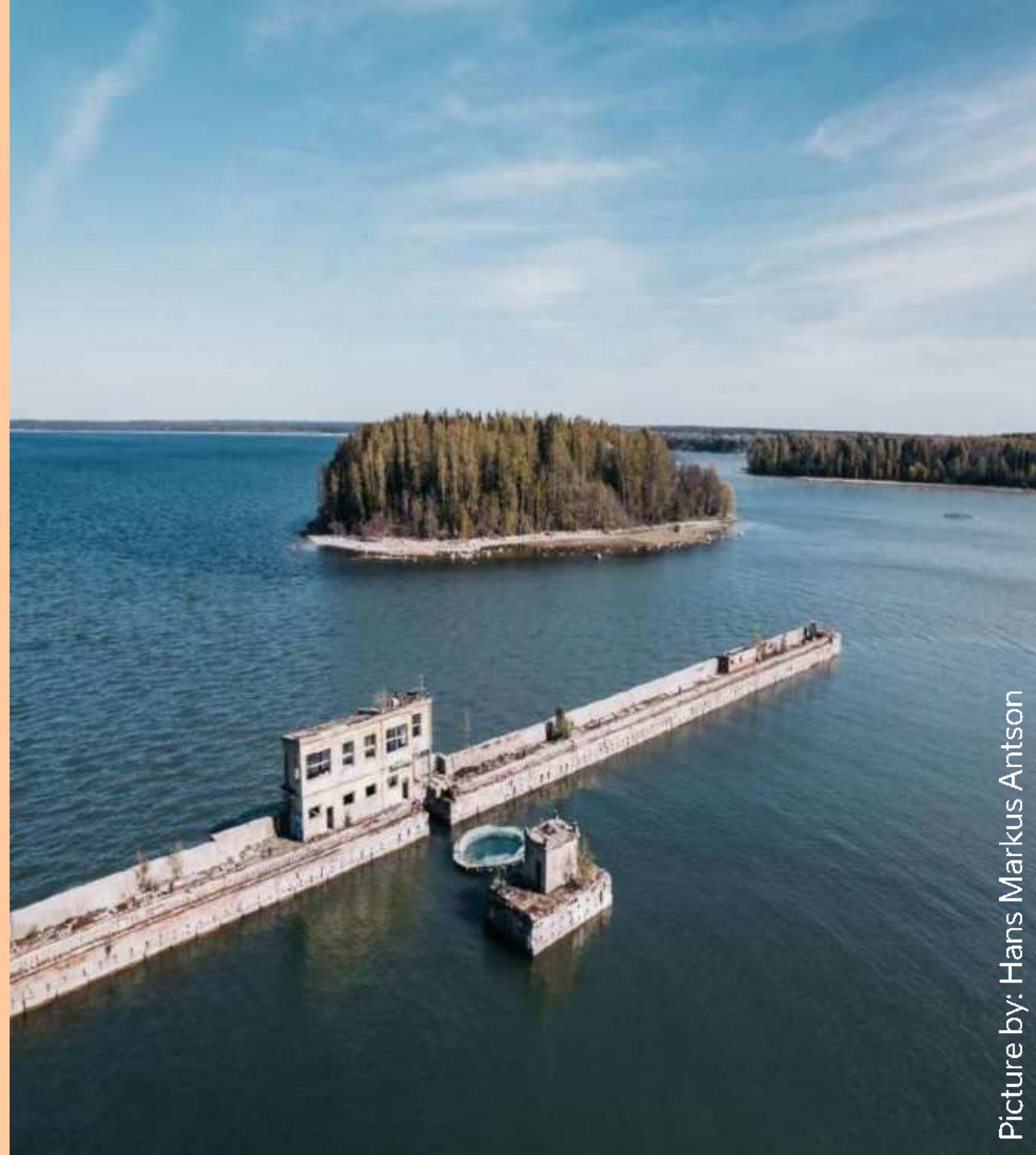
Hara harbour- ex submarine base

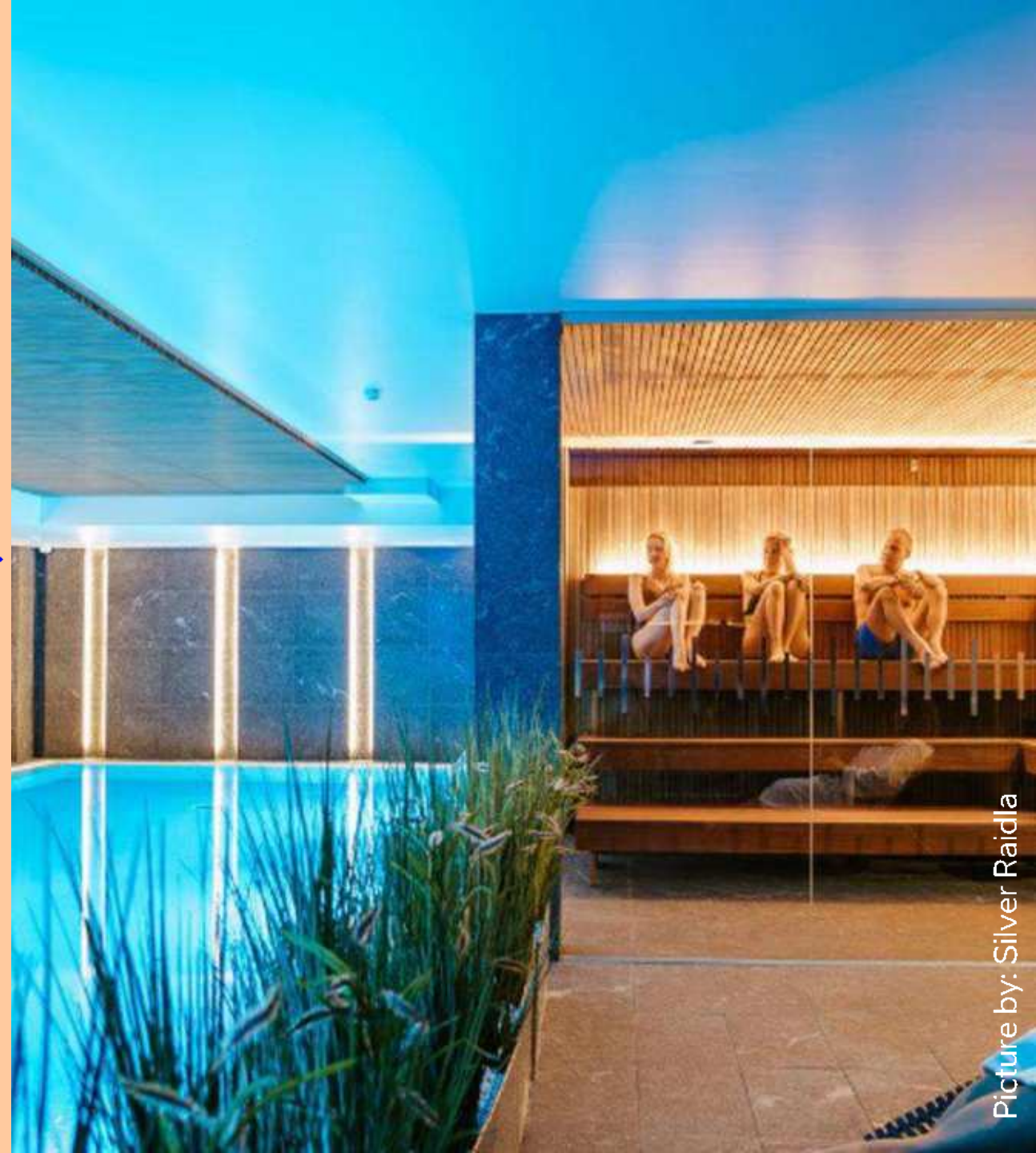

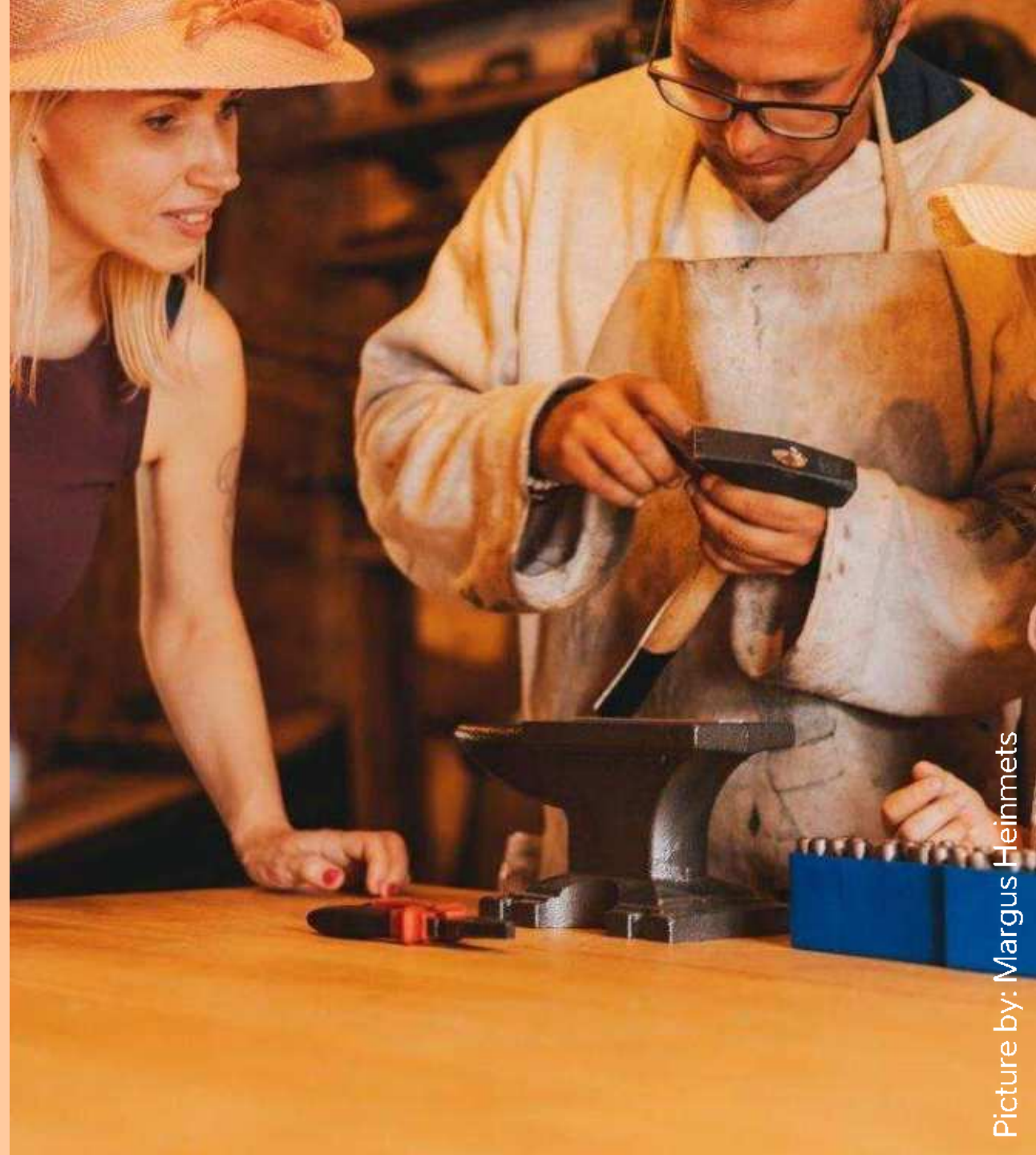

A wildlife watching safari with your own car in the Toosikannu Wildlife Park

- + Unique safari experience: Toosikannu Wildlife Park offers a distinctive wildlife-watching safari in your own car, with a track of approximately 11 km that takes 1 to 1.5 hours to complete.
- + Private and reservation-only: The park is a private territory, not a zoo, and entry requires a prior reservation. Wild animals roam freely and may appear at their own discretion; feeding or handling them is not permitted.
- + Booking and preparation: Safaris can be booked online up to 14 days in advance, and a safari map is provided in the confirmation email. Remember to bring your camera or binoculars for the best experience.

Põltsamaa Castle

- + Historical significance: Constructed in 1272 on the Põltsamaa River, the fortress was once the residence of King Magnus of Livonia and later transformed into a rococo-style palace, though much of it was destroyed in 1941.
- + Restoration and reopening: While the church was restored in 1952, the castle remained in ruins until its reopening in summer 2023, featuring an exposition on its history and offering access to the tower's observation platform.
- + Visitor experience: The complex includes craft workshops, a restaurant, and various buildings open for exploration, offering a mix of historical learning and leisure activities.

- + At the end of the visit, visitors can enjoy a cold beer or lemonade at the museum bar and visit gift shop.

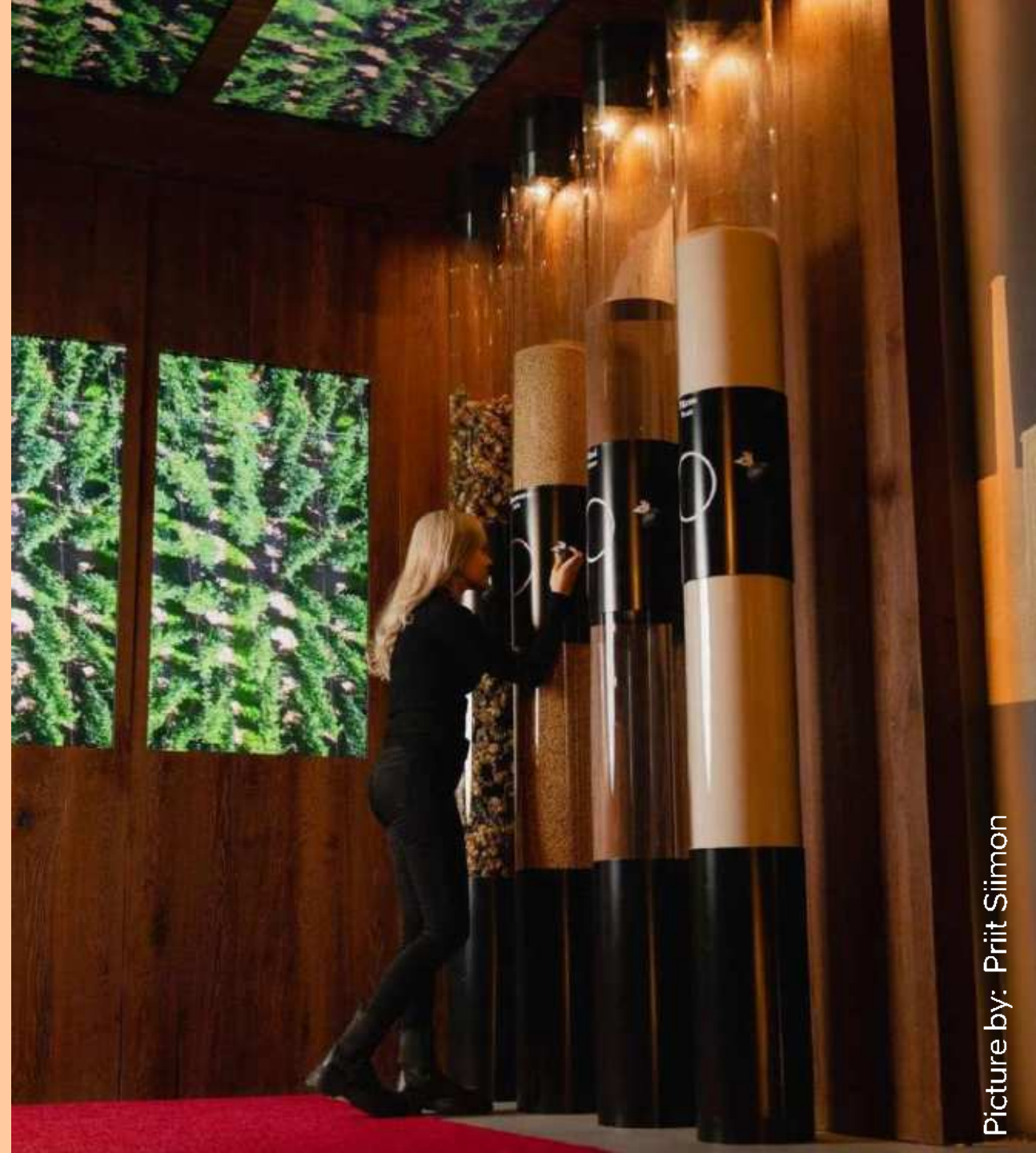

Lodjakoda & the "Jõmmu" barge

- + The Barge Chamber operates as a shipbuilding centre, theme park, museum, conference centre, and exhibition space with a café, Viking and barge tours, and a harbour.
- + At the Lodjakoda (Barge Chamber) everyone can see how a 24 m long two-masted Emajõgi-Peipsi barge is built. On big screen you can watch barge chronicles and slide shows. In addition, everyone is welcome to craft a barge model, learn sailor wisdom, visit a smithy, try old-fashioned barge-related work, and study the history of barge shipping
- + The Jõmmu barge is a timber vessel for transporting goods, the likes of which sailed on Estonian waterways from Hanseatic times until the mid-20th century. Jõmmu sails on River Emajõgi, Lake Peipus, and Lake Võrtsjärv from April to November.

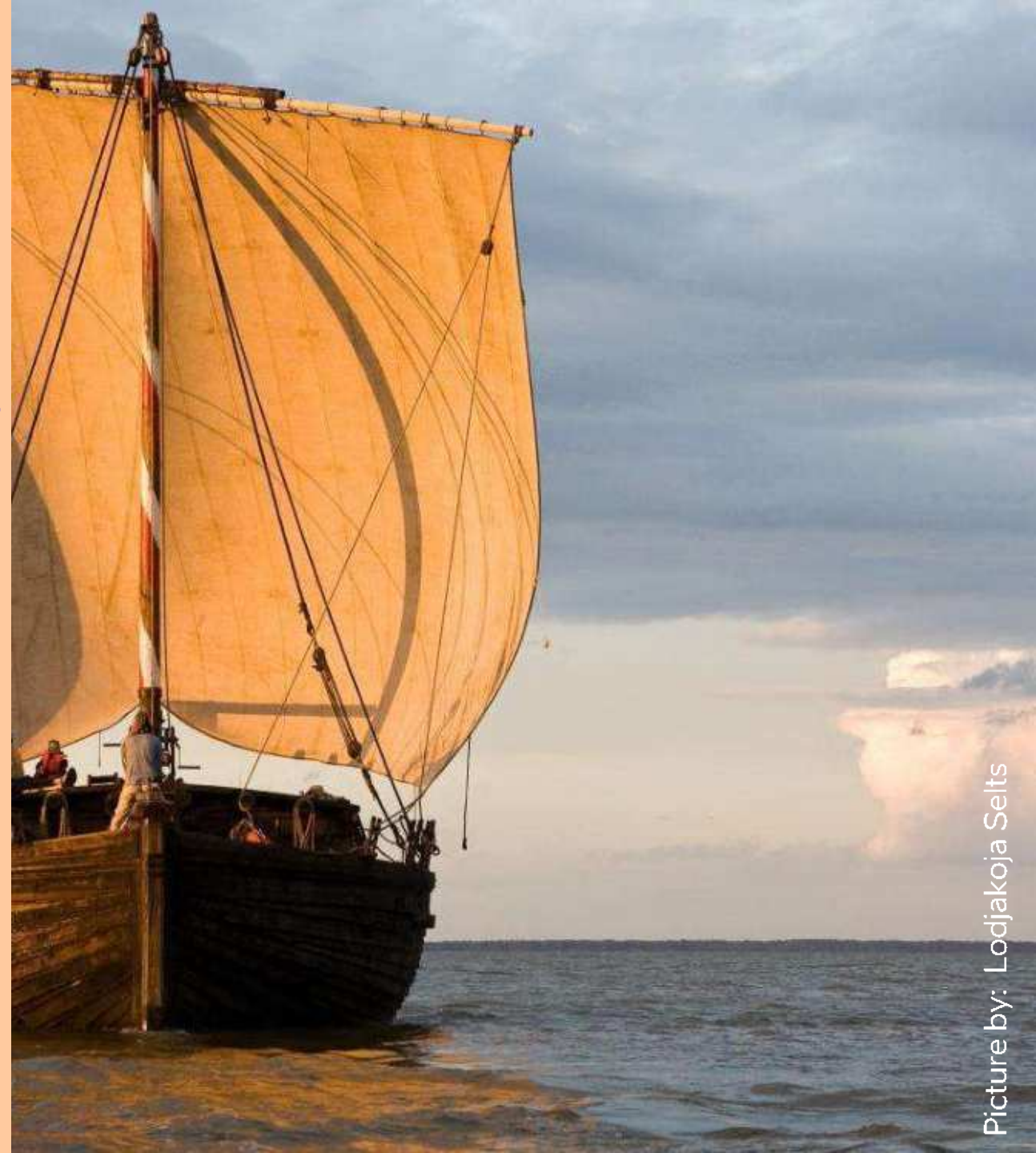

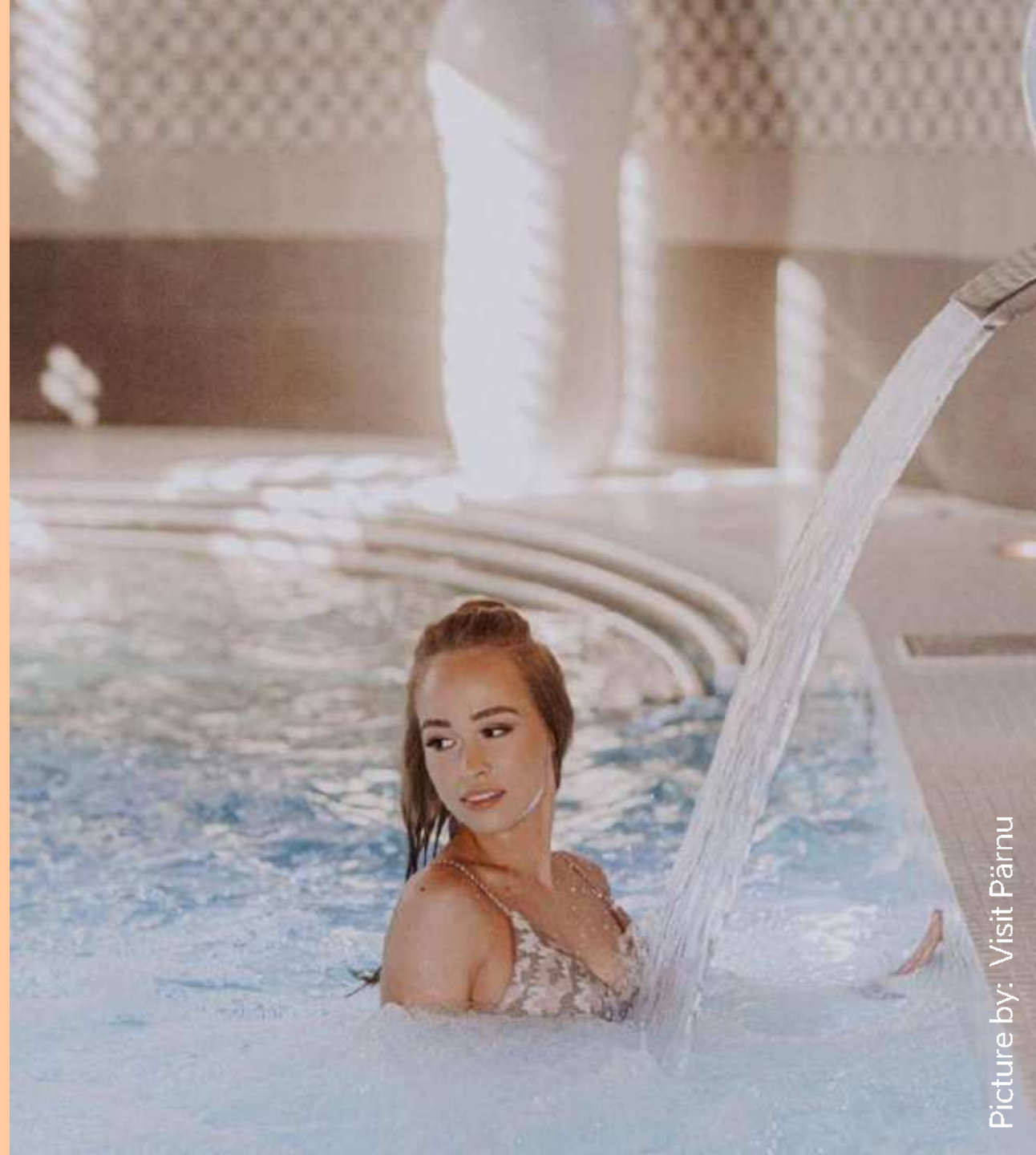

- + The villa has now been turned into a luxurious hotel and restaurant, offering modern comforts in a renovated historic town mansion.

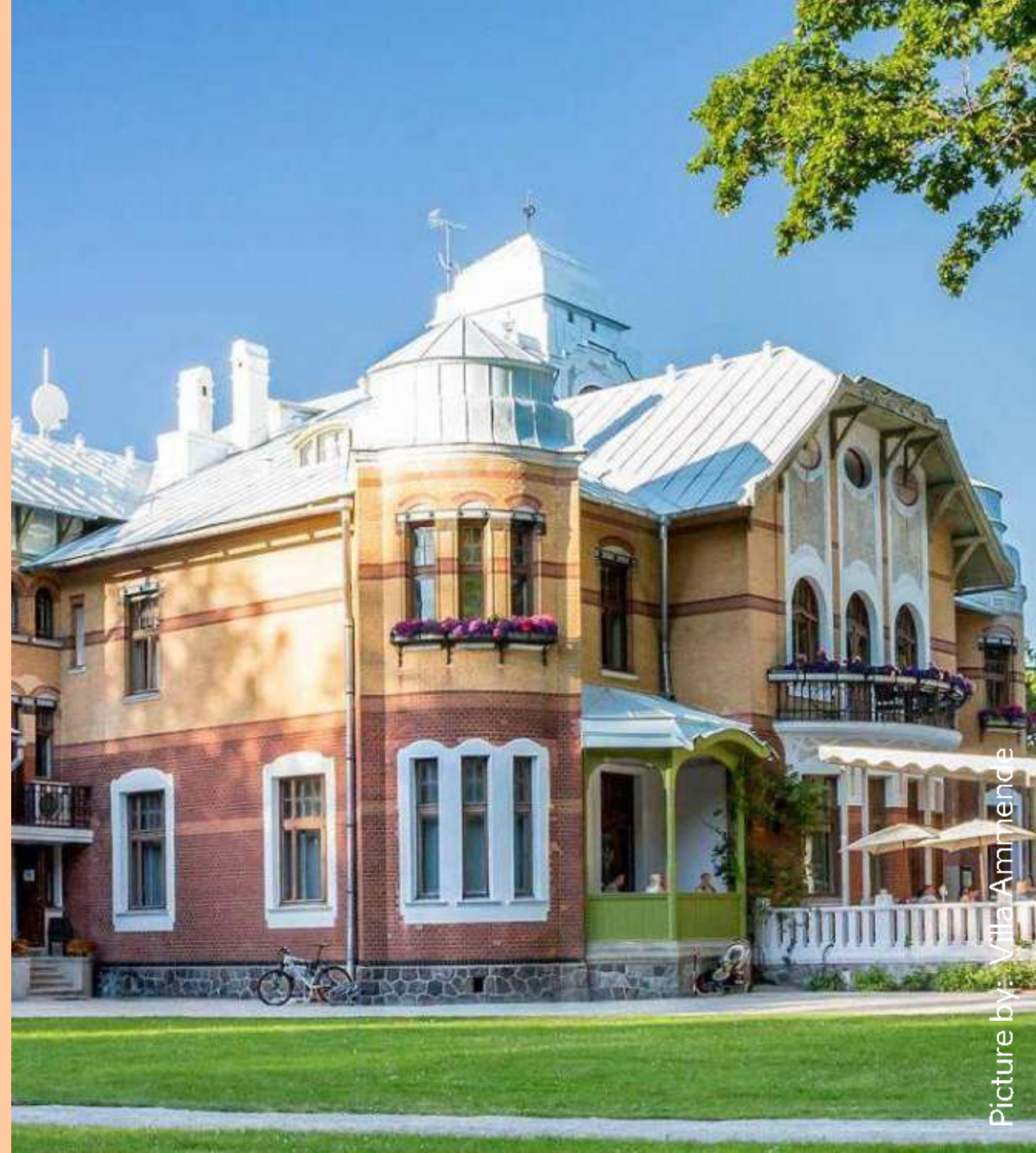
